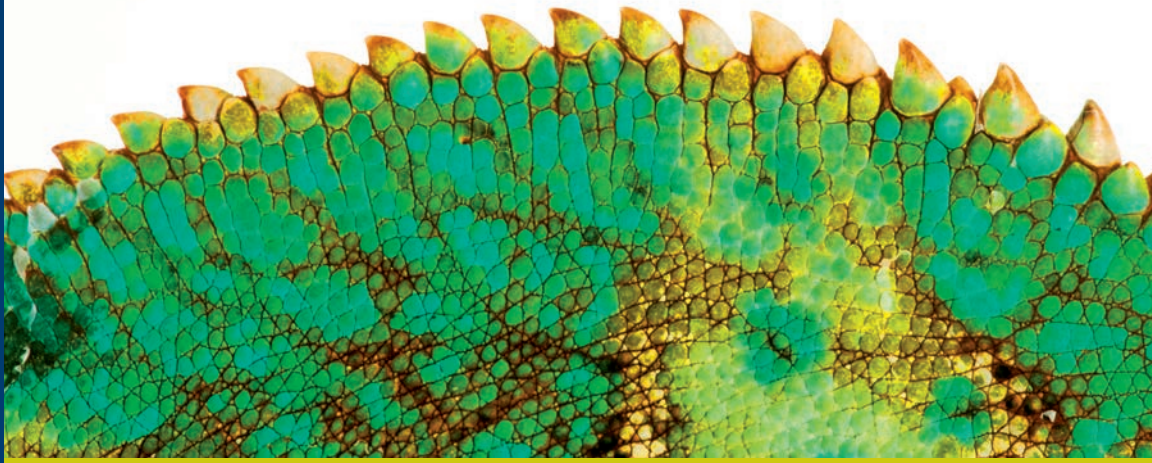

- Up to 25% of all GP consultations relate to the skin
- Dermatology is an area of medicine that is facing major changes from secondary to primary care
- The majority of GPs have little or no training in dermatology
- Hospital referral rates for dermatology are consistently high
- Open to all members of the primary care team

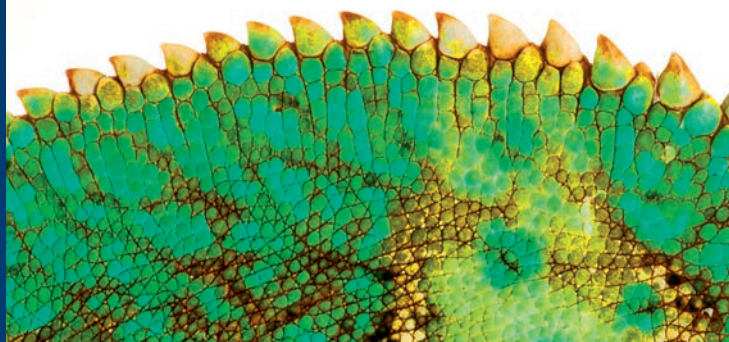
